

**CORONA NORCO UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT****CLASS TITLE: MAINTENANCE PAINTER****BASIC FUNCTION:**

Under the direction of an administrator, perform skilled work in painting, redecorating and surface preparation of buildings, furniture and equipment; maintain the painting for the interiors and exteriors of facilities.

**ESSENTIAL DUTIES:**

- Perform skilled work in painting, redecorating and surface preparation of buildings, furniture and equipment; maintain paint for interiors and exteriors of facilities.
- Perform duties in the preparation of painting surfaces including applying primer, sanding, sealing, patching and painting assigned surfaces; scrape and fill in voids to prepare surfaces for painting or repainting; apply undercoats and finish coats to a variety of surfaces; mix paints and match blends,
- Use a brush, roller or spray equipment in applying paint, clear coats and other protective and decorative finishes to a variety of surfaces.
- Lay out and paint athletic courts, fields and parking lots.
- Operate a variety of equipment including pressure washer and sandblaster; operate various aerial platforms; may operate a forklift and utilize various hand and power tools.
- Maintain various records and work orders.
- Maintain a variety of tools, paint equipment, work area and District vehicle in a safe, clean and orderly condition.

**OTHER DUTIES:**

Perform related duties as assigned.

**KNOWLEDGE/ABILITIES:**

Methods, procedures, equipment and materials used in the painting trade.

Perform a variety of skilled duties in the painting of buildings and facilities, repair drywall; tape and texture surfaces.

Methods of preparing a variety of surfaces for painting and finish work.

Building codes related to the painting trade.

Operate and maintain tools, equipment and machinery.

Proper methods of storing equipment, materials and supplies.

Appropriate safety precautions and procedures.

Interpersonal skills using tact, patience and courtesy.

Communicate effectively both orally and in writing.

Basic computer skills.

Proper lifting techniques.

Accurate record-keeping techniques.

Mix and apply paints or other surface coatings to buildings, equipment and furniture.

Plan and layout work.

Erect and work from ladders, rigging and scaffolding.

Meet schedules and time lines.

**EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE:**

High School Diploma or equivalent supplemented by completion of an approved apprenticeship program in painting or two years of journey-level experience in a painting trade.

**LICENSES AND OTHER REQUIREMENTS:**

Valid California Class C driver's license, TB Test Clearance, Criminal Justice Fingerprint Clearance, Pre-employment Safety Videos. Forklift Certificate

**PHYSICAL DEMANDS:**

Dexterity of hands and fingers to operate specialized equipment and tools.

Hear and speak to exchange information.

See to perform duties.

Reach overhead, above the shoulders and horizontally.

Bend at the waist, kneel or crouch.

Climb ladders and work from heights.

Walk or stand for extended periods of time.

Exposure to chemicals, dust, dirt and oil/grease.

Regular exposure to vapors from paints and solvents.

Lift, carry, push or pull objects weighing up to 50 pounds and 51 pounds with assistance

Exposure to hot, cold, wet, humid, or windy conditions.
