The purpose of the **Superintendent Parent Advisory Committee (SPAC)** was shared. Parents are selected from various committees at each school sites to provide the Superintendent with information from the community and provide accurate information regarding district activities to the community. Members of this committee should share out all information from the meeting with their respective committees and school communities.

- **Welcome and Introductions by Dr. Sam Buenrostro, Superintendent**
 - Board Member Lisa Marroquin was introduced.
- **Superintendents Updates**
 - Dr. Buenrostro reaffirmed that Board Members do listen to all constituents regarding concerns for safety and mask mandates.
 - Masks are no longer required in the classroom per state guidelines
 - COVID rates are currently low in the Community.
 - Use of technology is a positive gain from the pandemic. CNUSD students now have access to technology more than ever before.
 - **District Recognitions**
 - Roosevelt HS Band was showcased in Fresno – This is a high honor
 - CIF Girls Basketball Championship awarded to Santiago HS
 - CIF Girls Wrestling Championship awarded to Corona HS
 - Three CIF Championships Awarded to Centennial HS – Boys' Wrestling, Girls Water Polo, and Boys' Basketball. The Boys Basketball team won the State Championship and are ranked number 2 in the Nation.
 - Promotions for 6th – 8th grade will be held in person on campus for 2022.
 - High Schools will have in person Graduations either on their school site fields (Corona & Norco) or in arenas for the larger schools (Centennial, Roosevelt & Santiago)
 - **Ed. Services Updates by Lisa Simon**
 - Full day Kinder to start 22/23
 - A strong robust Summer School is scheduled for Summer 2022 (2 Sessions).
 - High School Summer Locations: Roosevelt HS, Centennial HS, and Corona HS which will be held at Lee V. Pollard HS due to construction on their site
 - K-8 Summer School locations will be announced soon.
- **Strategic Plan by Dr. Charla Capps**
 - The LCAP and Strategic Plan process and purpose was explained
 - The community was surveyed, and the community expressed that academic excellence, student wellbeing, equity, and governance were the most important topics.
 - The group was informed on how data is used to establish the LCAP Process and how data influences the LCAP Goals.

- The group was informed that the LCAP Advisory Committee, the Superintendents Advisory Committee, District English Learners Advisory Committee, the Community Advisory Committee, and CNUSD students are consulted to give input on the LCAP.
- An community survey will be launched soon regarding the LCAP.
- The three LCAP Goals were outlined and how they relate to the CNUSD Strategic Plan was explained.
- Instructions for break-out rooms and Padlet feedback were shared.
- Members joined break-out rooms for collaboration and to post Padlet comments.
- Dr. Sam Buenrostro finished the meeting with closing words and commendations for the valuable parent input.
