- Welcome and Introductions by Dr. Jeremy Goins
  - o Meeting opened
- Superintendent Updates by Dr. Samuel Buenrostro, CNUSD Superintendent
  - All members were reminded that their voice matters. All are encouraged to share what they are experiencing in our CNUSD community at each SPAC meeting, to help the district better serve its students.
  - O All members were informed that Board Member Lisa Marroquin is currently absent due to a health emergency. Members were assured that a Board Member will be present at all meetings and that Mrs. Marroquin looks forward to meeting the group at the next meeting.
  - The CNUSD State of the District will be held at Santiago HS on October 20, 2022. Site Principals and city personnel, such as City Council and local legislature, will be present to discuss district goals, obstacles, and pertinent needs. SPAC members are also invited to attend this special event.

#### • Purpose & Format by Dr. Charla Capps

- o The purpose of SPAC meetings, member selection, and meeting format were explained.
- All meetings will be held via zoom. The beginning segment of each meeting will be informational and cover district programs and special events. The ending segment of each meeting will transition into smaller breakout groups, where member questions and feedback will be collected.

#### • Bullying Awareness Month by Tricia Thompson

- October 2022 is Kindness Month at CNUSD in honor of National Anti-Bullying Month and bullying prevention.
- o The district's goal is to develop empathy, self-efficacy, persistence, and goal-setting skills in students to curb bullying practices and help victims.
- o An Anti-Bullying Parent Information Meeting will take place at the Parent Center on October 13, 2022 at 6:30 pm.
- CNUSD counselors are now available at all school sites and will also be participating in the Kindness Campaign throughout October 2022. Services will include family activities, student activities, and Kindness Care packages for the community.

#### • CTE Expo by Dr. Gina Boster

- Over 100 booths will be present at this year's expo and many of which will be hands-on (i.e. computer mechanics, gaming, etc.).
